Senate Bill 2772 – Affirms authority of Legislature to appropriate funds and protects right of citizens to have a voice in that process; transfers \$1.15-billion in CARES Act funding into budget contingency fund for legislative appropriation, leaves \$100-million in Department of Finance & Administration fund for governor's discretionary spending

The Parents' Campaign favors a vote of yea on this bill
