#### SB 2695 Special Needs Vouchers

**Substitute Amendment 1:** Strike all of SB 2695 and replace with bill to establish position of autism services coordinator and a fund to pay for supplemental services for children with special needs, serving up to 4,000 children annually and managed by Mississippi Department of Health
