House Bill 530 Conference Report – provides higher salaries for certified teachers at all experience levels and classifications, including minimum starting pay of \$41,500; overall average salary increase of \$5,140; annual step increases; larger pay bumps in years 5, 10, 15, and 20; \$2,500 increase in year 25; and provides a \$2,000 salary increase to assistant teachers; all provisions effective July 1, 2022

The Parents' Campaign favors a vote of yea on this bill
