House - 2022 Legislative Session

Senate Bill 3164 – amended in House to completely eliminate state income taxes over a period of years; revenue loss estimated to be \$700-million in first year alone and \$2-billion when phased in, eliminating 1/3 of General Fund

The Parents' Campaign favors a vote of nay on this bill
