House of Representatives House Bill 1494

Provides level funding for K-12, including the Mississippi Adequate Education Program (MAEP), teacher supply funds, and the National Board Certification program. Fully funds the Chickasaw Cession interest payment. Funding is \$25.5-million above the Legislative Budget Recommendation, which includes \$16.3-million to cover an increase in the cost of state retirement. Underfunds the MAEP by \$232-million.

The Parents' Campaign favors a yeas vote.
