### House - 2023 Legislative Session

**House Bill 1365** – prohibits school districts from paying assistant teachers less in local contribution funds than was paid in such funds in the immediately preceding year; amended to also provide a \$3,000 annual salary increase for assistant teachers to bring them to a state-funded minimum salary of \$20,000

***The Parents' Campaign favors a vote of yea on this bill***
