## **House - 2023 Legislative Session**

House Bill 1365 – prohibits school districts from paying assistant teachers less in local contribution funds than was paid in such funds in the immediately preceding year; amended to also provide a \$3,000 annual salary increase for assistant teachers to bring them to a state-funded minimum salary of \$20,000
