House Bill 1431 – School District Consolidation. Creates a task force to develop recommendations for consolidating school districts into one per county with a single county board of education and superintendent; out of 20 task force members only one is designated specifically to represent public schools.

The Parents' Campaign favors a vote of nay on this bill.
