## House - 2025 Legislative Session

House Bill 1432 – Charter School Expansion; Loosening of Oversight and Accountability. Allows charter schools to be authorized without local school board approval in districts rated C, until adjustments are made to state accountability model. Allows charter schools serving special needs to be authorized in any district regardless of accountability rating. Allows multiple authorizers of charter schools, weakening accountability and oversight.

## The Parents' Campaign favors a vote of nay on this bill.
