House - 2025 Legislative Session

House Bill 1435 – Open Enrollment/Public School Choice. Allows students to transfer to a district outside of their own residence with the approval of the receiving district. Creates a significant administrative burden on districts by requiring they report three times a year the enrollment capacity and space available for each school and each grade as well as the district's policy on student transfers.

The Parents' Campaign favors a vote of nay on this bill.
