## Senate - 2025 Legislative Session

**House Bill 1902 – Private School Funding.** Amended by Senate to: remove increase in funding for private schools, reverting to current level of \$9-million annually via Children’s Promise Act tax credits, and require annual PEER review of participating private schools to determine the number of qualifying children enrolled and how funds were expended.

*The Parents’ Campaign favors a vote of nay on this bill.*
