### House - 2026 Legislative Session

**House Bill 4073 Conference Report – PERS Changes.** Amends PERS statute to reduce years of service required for retirement in Tier 5 from 35 to 30 years; reduce required days of separation from employment following retirement from 90 to 30 days; allow retired teachers and other state employees to return to state employment after 30 days and receive 80% of salary while continuing to draw full PERS benefits, with employer paying full contribution into PERS system (retiree accrues no additional PERS benefits or years of service); and other provisions.

*The Parents' Campaign favors a yea vote on the conference report.*
